- 💧 How RainWise helps to market your business to customers

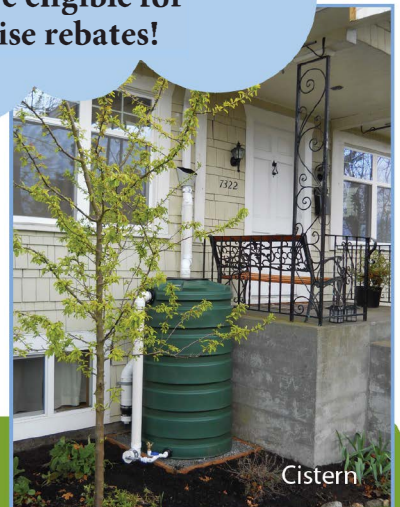
