
Voluntary Proposers Meeting and MSVWBE Contractor Networking Event

Monday, March 11, 2019 1 – 3 p.m. Fife Community Center 2111 54th Avenue E Fife, WA

The Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) is continuing the contract procurement process for the SR 167 70th Avenue E Vicinity Bridge Replacement Project. WSDOT will hold an informational meeting for shortlisted design-build teams on Monday, March 11. The meeting will consist of a presentation on the project by WSDOT, followed by a one-hour MSVWBE subcontracting and networking session. The shortlisted teams will be posted on WSDOT's Contract Ad and Award webpage (www.wsdot. wa.gov/biz/contaa/Contracts/70thAvenue.html) on Monday, February 25. This is the first of three design-build contracts that will be used to construct the SR 167 Completion Project over the next 11 years.

The project involves new bridge construction over I-5, road widening, intersection improvements, a trailhead parking facility and shared use trail construction, and partial building demolition and remodeling. The project will require trucking and hauling, paving, demolition, landscaping, traffic control, building reconstruction and numerous other types of work. Construction is expected to begin in the fall of 2019 and to take about two years to complete.

WSDOT strongly encourages minority, small, veteran and women's business enterprise (MSVWBE) firms to attend and network with the shortlisted design-build teams for the project.
