Dr. Harold Amos

The first African American to chair a department of Harvard Medical School was Dr. Harold Amos. After serving in World War II, he enrolled at Harvard - earning his M.A. and Ph.D. The first African American to earn a doctoral degree from Harvard, Amos then joined the Harvard Medical School faculty in 1954 as a lecturer. Moving through the ranks, he became a full professor and chair of the school's bacteriology department in 1968 and again in 1975. Amos was named professor emeritus in 1988.

Amos study of cells, bacterial metabolism and virology was essential to the understanding and treatment of diseases such as diabetes and some forms of immune deficiency. He published over seventy scientific papers. In 1974, Amos was named advisor to President Richard Nixon serving on the President's Cancer Panel. He also served on the National Cancer Advisory Board for more than 30 years. With a teaching career of almost 50 years at Harvard, Amos was well known for encouraging many students of color to enter scientific and teaching careers as well as working to increase the number of minority faculty members at medical schools.
